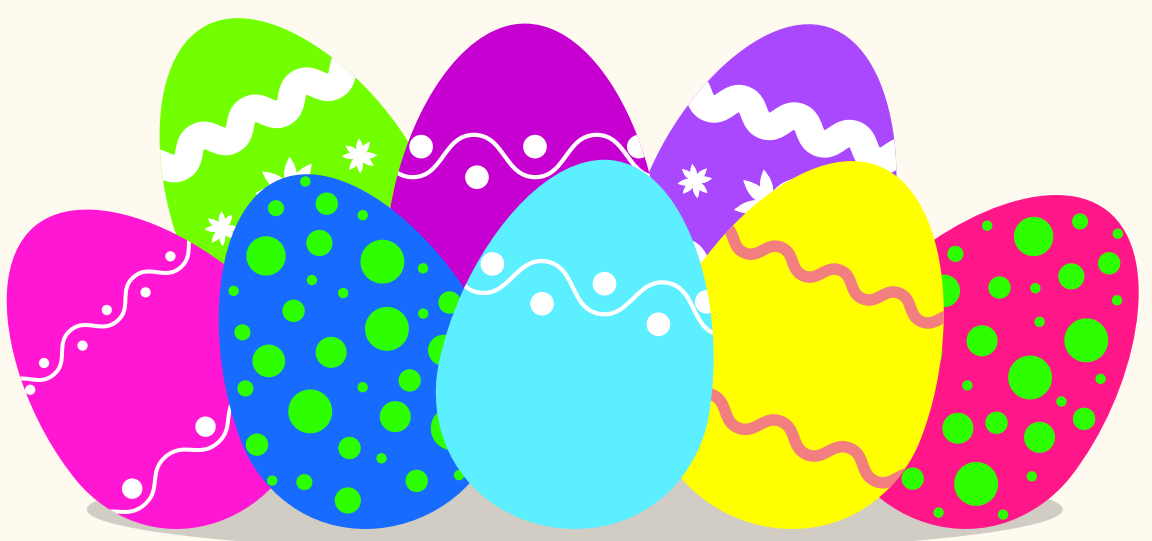
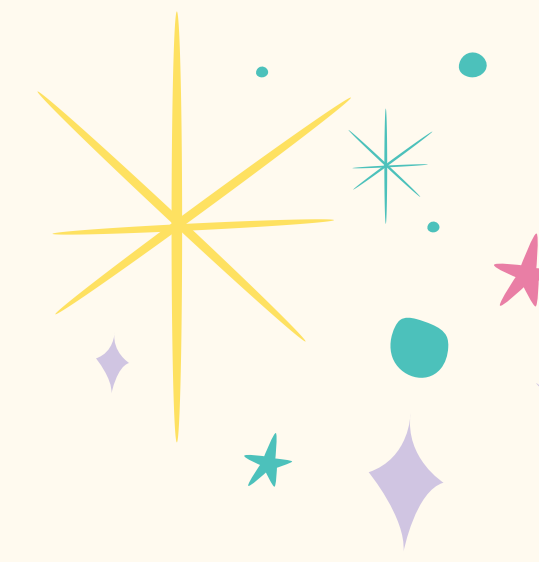
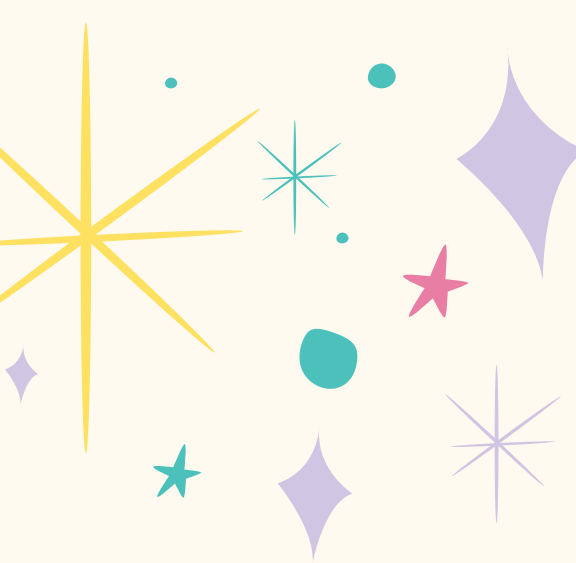


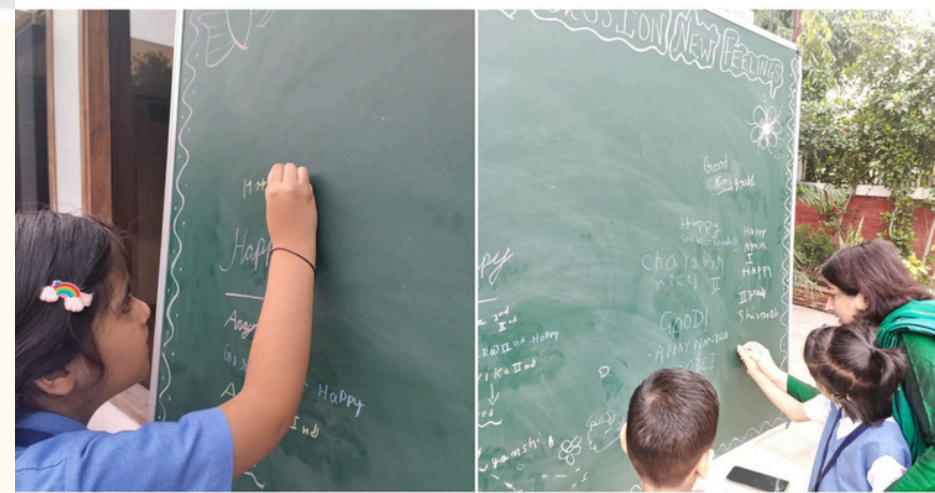


EVENT: EASTER DAY

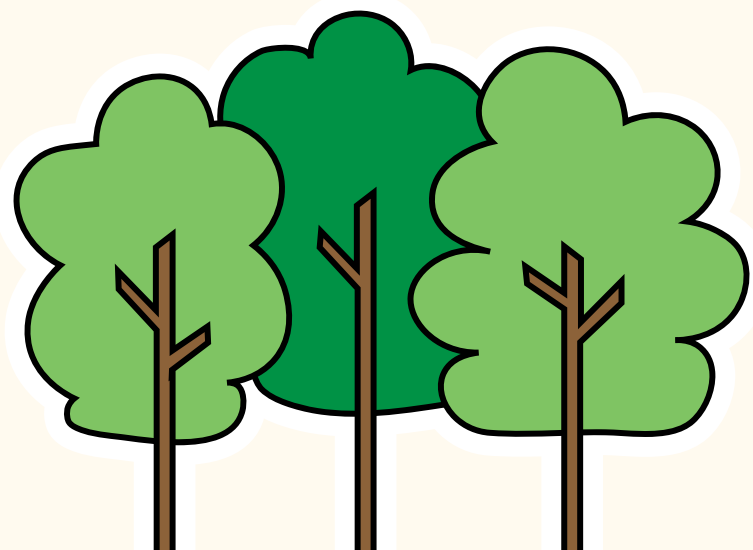




EARTH DAY

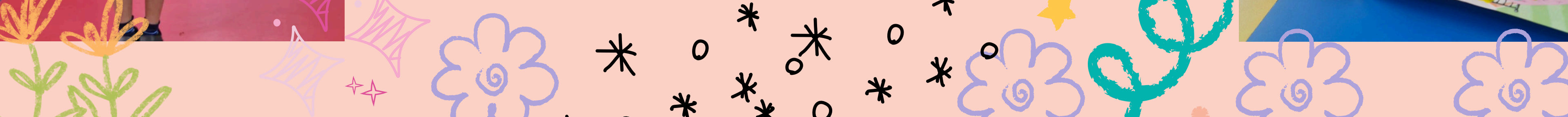




WORLD BOOK DAY
